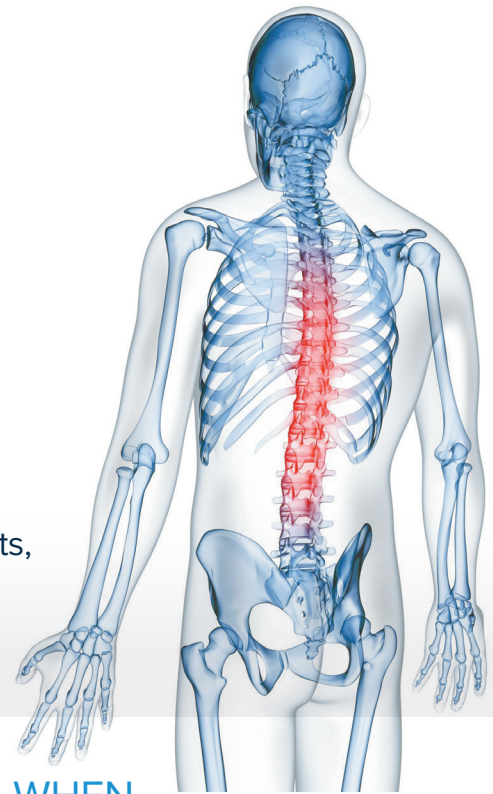


Back Up

WORKSHOPS AND LEARNING OUTCOMES INCLUDE:

Session 1: Backs and Necks

with *Orthopaedic Surgeons* Dr Ian Farey and Dr Nathan Hartin

- Perform a quick and thorough examination of the back and neck
- Develop a care path for the management of back and neck pain

Session 2: Hips and Shoulders

with *Orthopaedic Surgeons* Dr Joe Isaacs and Dr Ben Cass

- Assess and manage common hip and shoulder problems
- Utilise skills practiced at the hip/shoulder workshop

Session 3: Radiology and Physiotherapy

with *Radiologist* Dr Brett Lurie and *Physiotherapist* Marita Lennon

- Develop a set of imaging guidelines for investigating painful joints
- Participate in postoperative rehabilitation care for people having joint surgery

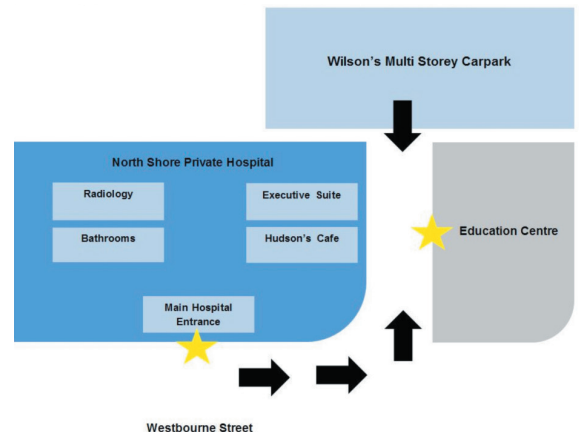
